ENGLISH TEACHING ACTIVITIES



Teacher Jeanette feels very fortunate and excited to be part of the **BILINGUAL PROGRAMME** that has been implemented at Qing Pu Elementary School. And the students of our school are very privileged to be part of this programme.

During the summer vacation students attended an English Summer Camp. Students had a chance to participate in outdoor and indoor activities daily, and they enjoyed the practical activities a lot because they could eat what they made. The theme of the week was “FUN IN THE SUN.” And everyone kicked off the summer with a week filled with fun and excitement! The schedule also included activities that helped to improve their listening and speaking skills. A lot of emphasis was given to building self-confidence in students.
